Connected by a bridge to the mainland, it is home to Australia's most popular natural wildlife experience, the Penguin Parade, as well as an abundance of unique nature and inspiring experiences. Each night at sunset, watch the smallest penguins in the world as they march up the beach to their burrows in this amazing ancient ritual. The nightly Penguin Parade allows visitors the chance to see this spectacular natural phenomenon from a range of exclusive viewing options. 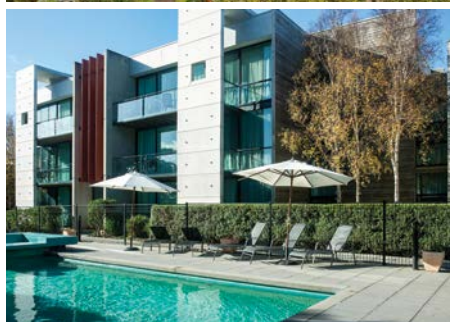


ADVENTURE ISLAND

KOALA CONSERVATION RESERVE

Get close to wild koalas in their natural habitat in one of Phillip Island's last remnant woodland reserves at the Koala Conservation Reserve, home to 17 koalas boasting two elevated treetop boardwalks which allow visitors an up-close viewing.

You may also spot other Australian wildlife throughout the bushland – swamp wallabies, brushtail and ringtail possums, echidnas and over 150 species of birds.

Learn the history of koala conservation on Phillip Island in the interactive museum and exhibition space.

MOONLIT SANCTUARY WILDLIFE CONSERVATION PARK

Fantastic opportunities to get close to Australian native animals at this award-winning wildlife conservation park.
